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TEACHER TRAINING AND LEARNING DELIVERY

From March to June and as of June 22, 2020, the ICT Service through its Educational Technology Unit (EdTech) has already **trained a total of 337,486 public school teachers in ICT-based teaching which covers 40% of the public school teaching population.**

An additional **10,521 private school teachers** have also been trained by the Department.

These trainings made use of online webinars were the number of participants could reach 45,000 unique individuals allowing DepEd to rapidly scale its capacity building program. Quality was assured by requiring activities to be completed and submitted before the release of certificate.

The 40% trained teachers only count those who have received certificates; however, more teachers have viewed the recordings of the webinars which are made available in the internet. Local echo webinars are also not included in the following data.

The webinars offered by ICTS-EdTech are summarized in the table below. Teachers attend multiple webinars indicating immense interest in the use of ICT-based tools to respond to COVID-19.
