Subject: **LAUNCHING OF THE PILOT COURSE ON PUBLIC HEALTH
AND EDUCATION DATA ANALYTICS BEYOND COVID-19**

The Department of Education (DepEd)—in close coordination with the Philippine Society of Public Health Physicians (PSPHP), USAID, and RTI International—will conduct a capacity building activity on Public Health Data Analytics to Support Post-COVID Decision-Making Regarding School Reopening. The pilot implementation phase will include selected schools in Regions V, VI, and VII that are part of the limited face-to-face pilot.

The course is divided into four parts that aim to introduce school officials and school health personnel to public health, prevention of common diseases in children, disease surveillance and pandemics, and how public health data are collected, analyzed, reported, and used.

Attached is the list of participating schools (**Annex A**) provided by the RTI International to the Bureau of Learners Support Services-School Health Division (BLSS-SHD) as of 22 November 2021.

The launching of the pilot course will be held virtually via Zoom on **14 December 2021**, Tuesday, from **1:00-3:00 pm**. 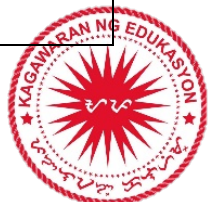
